These discussions have allowed me to share the vision for the organisation, how it will operate, and what membership will look like.

The feedback received has been overwhelmingly positive, with many expressing a strong willingness to contribute and support the growth of the organisation. We are currently in the process of officially establishing our first branch on the Central Coast, which marks an exciting milestone for the future of Concerned Young Australians. I have distributed a significant number of business cards, and awareness of our organisation is spreading rapidly.

Following the successful launch of the Central Coast branch, we intend to expand into other regions across New South Wales, including Shoalhaven, Newcastle, the Hunter Valley, New England, and any other areas where there is sufficient interest to establish a branch.
